Australia-Taiwan Emerging Business Leaders Program

About the Program

The Australia-Taiwan Business Council Limited (ATBC) is conducting the Australia-Taiwan Emerging Business Leaders Program (Program), as a steppingstone in deepening the B2B relationship between Australia and Taiwan by identifying and encouraging the next generation of business leaders.

The Program will run over the 2022 year.

The key outcome of the Leaders Program is to promote, develop and connect emerging business leaders from Australia and Taiwan, particularly in the following sectors:

- Renewable energy
- Innovation
- Education
- Tourism
- Agriculture
- Fintech

The Program is intended to consist of the following activities:

- virtual and in-person forums, workshops, and networking events; and
- promotion and profiling of Leaders Program participants through communications, publications and culminate in the Emerging Business Leaders' Summit in October-November 2022.

The Program will create opportunities for participants to share their experience and insights through promotion and profiles and will be supported



to maintain their professional networks and pursue career opportunities in the Australia-Taiwan bilateral relationship as Program Alumni

Selection of participants

Approximately 8 individuals from Taiwan and 8 individuals from Australia will be selected to participate in the Program.

Participants will be early-to-mid career professionals with professional experience, expertise or demonstrated interest in the Australia-Taiwan economic relationship.

Participants will be selected through a competitive application process and must:

- hold a bachelor's degree qualification or higher;
- demonstrate professional experience with or interest in the Australia-Taiwan economic relationship (internships or applied research will be considered)
- commit to the full participation in the Program.

ATBC will liaise with stakeholders including Australian Government and state and territory agencies, as well as universities and industry associations, and counterpart bodies in Taiwan (including CIECA/ROC-ABC), to identify prospective participants.

Closing date for applications

Applications are now open and close on 31st March 2022.

This unique program has been established by the ATBC with the support of the Australian Government to help young professionals working in global business, international trade or new and emerging technologies to take their career to the next level.



Australia and Taiwan

The Australia-Taiwan economic relationship is rapidly growing. Australian businesses in the education, tourism, natural resources. and agricultural sectors have found sustained success in Taiwan's reliable markets. Additionally, high-tech sectors including the digital economy, renewable energy and Australia's emerging hydrogen industry are promising areas for future collaboration and new business opportunities in Australia and Taiwan.

For more than three decades the ATBC has built strong relationships between Australian and Taiwanese leaders to promote and expand two-way trade and investment.
